Production (P) Stickers

“Temporary Holding”, “Production only” or “P” stickers can only be used by the farmer’s up to 31st October, unless a derogation has been sought from Red Tractor. Merchants are advised to check their contracts against the Red Tractor Crops Scheme member checker to identify ‘P’ i.e. no storage members and schedule collections from these farms as a priority.
